You are not allowed to have yard sales on Pike County Housing Authority Property, There is not enough room for parking.

Beginning January 1, 2017 Pike
County Housing will be smoke free.
There will be no smoking within 15

you are not able to get
electricity in your name you
will not be able to rent from
us.

You may only have 2 pets. They must weigh no more than 35 pounds. You also must tell us that you have a pet because there is a \$200.00 pet deposit that is payable over 6 months.

For example, if the actual last day of the month is a Saturday or Sunday, your payment must be here on Friday before 5:00 pm.
