INSPECTIONS ARE CONTINUING-You will receive a notice on your door before inspections at your property. Inspections will take place if you are not home. You will receive a letter from this office letting you know if you fail or pass. If you fail, you will be given details to the reasons why you failed. We will then give you a new date for a re-inspection. If you do not pass the re-inspection, this will be considered a violation of your lease, and leave you subject to eviction.

#### CALL THE OFFICE FOR ANY REPAIRS-Any repairs or replacements,

such as light bulbs, need to be called into the office. We must put in a work order for the repair to be done. DO NOT STOP MAINTENANCE WHILE THEY ARE MOWING, WEED EATING, OR ARE AT YOUR UNIT FOR OTHER REPAIRS TO ASK FOR ANY ADDITIONAL PROBLEMS TO BE FIXED.

PCHA has been interested in selling the properties in Perry and Baylis for several years. The process of selling these properties has begun. We are only in the beginning stages, this could possibly take up to 6-12 months.

We prefer to sell to another entity to keep the units affordable. We also prefer to transfer you to available units in other towns that PCHA currently owns and manages. If we are unable to do these things, a tenant protection voucher will be issued, which would allow you to move somewhere else, and have rent be affordable through federal subsidy known as Section 8/HCV.

We will do everything possible to make this a smooth transition for everyone. If you are interested in being transferred, we will be glad to assist you any way we can.



#### LANDESS TERRACE CORRALS



The charge is \$50.00 per load. If you have in home help, you need to make it clear they are not to use the corrals as dumpsters, All boxes need to be broken down to fit into the tote.

If tenants and their in home help cannot keep the corrals clean, they will be removed. This issues has been addressed numerous times.
